#### RE: 3B SCHOLARSHIP FOR GRADUATES OF Grand Canyon HIGH SCHOOL

Each year our American Legion John Ivens Post #42 of Grand Canyon presents a 3B Scholarship award to a qualifying graduate of Grand Canyon High School. This award is part of our American Legion's Children & Youth Program and began in 1981 when members of our post voted to set up this scholarship program to give graduates the opportunity for higher education that they might otherwise not have had.

The annual 3B Scholarship award is currently \$5,000, with the recipient receiving \$1,000 for the first two semesters and \$500 for the next six semesters. This award is sent directly to the scholarship or financial aid office of the college, university, technical school, or trade/vocational school the student plans to attend. Should there be 2 qualified applicants for the 3B Scholarship, the award is divided equally between both, with each receiving \$500 the first two semesters and \$250 the next six. And should there be 3 qualified applicants, the American Legion may choose to add \$1,000 to the \$5,000 award and then divide the \$6,000 equally among the three, with each receiving \$2,000.

#### Eligibility

To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be seniors in the graduating class of 2025 or if graduation requirements were already met earlier by obtaining sufficient credits, then the prospective graduate may be eligible to apply. Applying is easy—just complete our 3B Scholarship Application, following all instructions, including writing a short essay, and submitting with requested attachments by the due date of **Friday March 28**, **2025**, to our American Legion office at the address listed on the application (please note, all applications must be <u>received</u> by **March 28**, **2025**, **not** postmarked on that date, for consideration).

We also have a <u>second</u> 3B Scholarship award of \$5,000 available, with this scholarship being awarded to a descendent (child or grandchild) of a current, paid-up, American Legion John Ivens Post #42 member. In this case, we request additional info regarding the Legion member's name and membership number.

We encourage all Grand Canyon High School graduates, as well as children or grandchildren of members of John Ivens Post #42, to take advantage of this outstanding opportunity to receive a 3B Scholarship.
