Dear Prospective Applicant:

RE: THE AMERICAN LEGION JOHN IVENS POST #42 3B SCHOLARSHIP (FOR DESCENDENTS OF CURRENT JOHN IVENS POST #42 MEMBERS)

Each year our American Legion John Ivens Post #42 of Grand Canyon presents a 3B Scholarship award to a qualifying descendent of a current or deceased member of our American Legion John Ivens Post #42. Our 3B Scholarship Program began in 1981 when members of our post voted to set up a scholarship fund to help give Grand Canyon High School graduates the opportunity for a higher education; several years later we added a second 3B Scholarship for descendents of current members of our post.

Our annual 3B Scholarship is \$5,000, with the recipient receiving \$1,000 the first two semesters and \$500 the next six semesters. Should there be 2 qualified applicants, the American Legion may elect to divide the award equally between both, with each receiving \$2,500: payments would be \$500 the first two semesters and \$250 the next six. And should there be 3 qualified applicants, the Legion may choose to add \$1,000 to the \$5,000 award and then divide the \$6,000 equally among the three, with each receiving \$2,000, so payments would be \$500 the first two semesters and \$250 the next four. Scholarship monies are sent directly to the scholarship or financial aid office of the college, university, technical institute, trade school, or vocational school the prospective student plans to attend.

Eligibility

To qualify for this scholarship, applicants must be a child or grandchild of a current member of our American Legion John Ivens Post #42 of Grand Canyon. By "current" member, this means one whose membership is paid in full for the 2020 membership year or a deceased member. Applying is easy—just complete our 3B Scholarship Application, following all instructions, and submit with required attachments, including a short essay (topic stated in application). Mail your application and attachments to our American Legion office so it is *received by* **Friday, March 25, 2022** (Please note: all applications must be <u>received</u> by the due date, not postmarked that date, to be considered for this scholarship award.) In early April our 3B Scholarship Award Committee will review the applications and make their selection.

We encourage descendents of our current Legion members to take advantage of this great opportunity!
