Asbestos Exposure and Military Veterans

Companies Put Our Navy at Risk

Without a doubt, the military branch most impacted by asbestos exposure is the U.S. Navy. Nearly every naval vessel built between 1930 and the late 1970s used construction materials containing asbestos. A leading source of exposure was asbestos insulation (e.g. spray-on asbestos, pipe covering) – provided to the military by outside companies.
